
Please RSVP for gatherings by calling or emailing your intention to attend. It's a really nice thing to do for yourself and it helps in our planning. Thank you!

The 4th Sunday of each month we have a "Oneness Blessing Opportunity" which begins at 10:00 a.m. and goes for one hour exactly. This is a way of coming together to have a collective opportunity to send light to the world. Each person who comes receives one Blessing. Then in silence we disappear to feel a sense of rapport and synthesis while being in the ONENESS. The Sunday Noon Meal serves a healthy, full meal to those in our area who are in need of nourishment and fellowship. It is served every Sunday and uses the Salvation Army site as its base facility. Currently more than 110 guests are served each Sunday.

This mission came out of the Mankato Hunger Task Force which was formed in the mid-80s. Starting with 5 churches sharing the task, it now has evolved into a base of 14 spiritual communities working together! Hope Interfaith Center has agreed to provide food and serve twice during each year.

Serving the Sunday Noon Meal involves the following: We will need approximately 16 people/units to help donate, make and serve the food. There are five categories – the main dish, a vegetable, salad, bread, butter and milk, and dessert. Jody has more information and there is a sign-up sheet at HIC.

This is a very worthwhile way to serve others and a good family activity, too. If you are unable to help serve that day, you can donate food (ask what is needed) or money to buy the food – there are many options available to come forward and serve!

Once again I will be offering the thirteen-month Leadership Program at HIC. We believe in honoring all paths. So we ask our students to hold on to the traditions from which they come from, if that is their wish. But we also ask them to be ready and willing to expand their horizons...to learn about other religions and faiths from around the world.

We study a great deal about "Our ONENESS". Come join us if you have a call to become an ordained Interfaith Minister and leader. Become part of the change you want to see in the world.

Since the inception of the Hope Interfaith Seminary, we have ordained many interfaith ministers. All are working in their own special ways to transform our society to a global community of Love.

The first six months of study is about the discovery of Self, after which you will begin to discover a spiritual fellowship called interfaith which is now transforming our society. The interfaith/oneness story includes a mix of traditions where there is a sense that God/Goddess/Essence resides in the image of man. Spiritual counseling techniques and the study of energy is included in these classes.

This thirteen-month program starts in January. We will meet one week-end a month at HIC, beginning at 7:00 p.m.

Friday evening, concluding at 5:00 p.m. Saturday afternoon. You will stay overnight at the Center and food will be communally shared.


